And You consistently blow my mind, and leave me wondering why

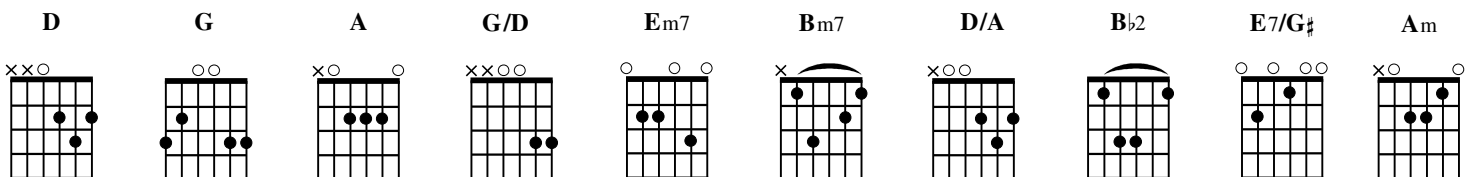
CHORUS 1
